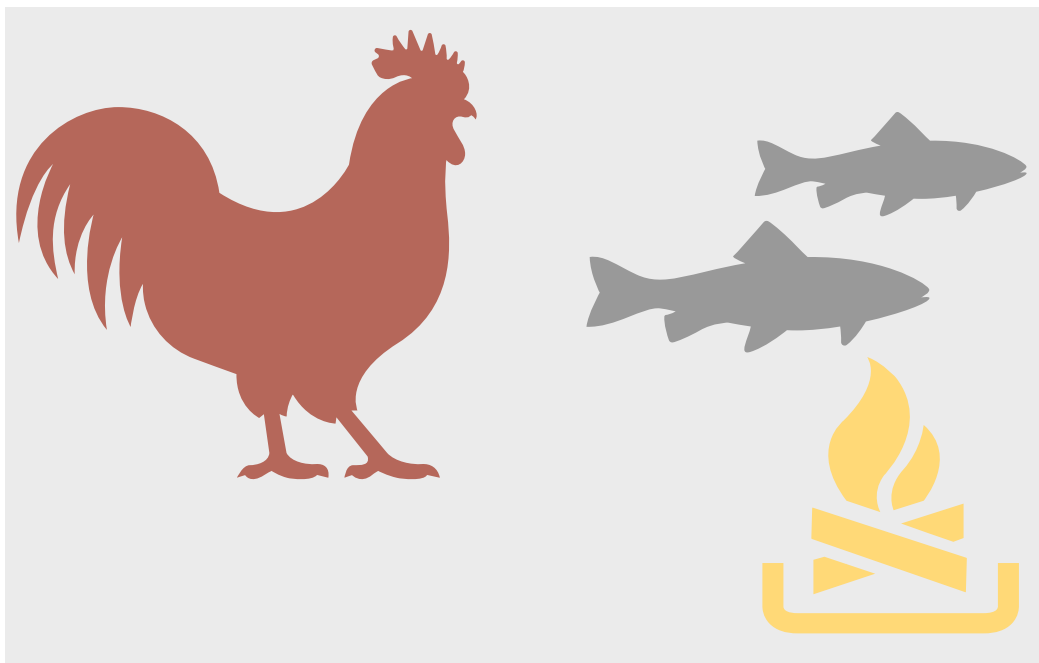
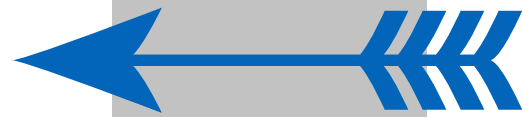


Growing the Fruit of the Spirit
