Livestream Worship

Until we have a vaccine for COVID-19, it will be a risk to come to worship at 118 Woodland Ave. We will continue to livestream our worship service and encourage anyone at higher risk to stay home and continue to worship in this way.



Handwashing & Hand Sanitizer

We will have plenty of hand sanitizer on hand. We encourage you to use it regularly.



Health Screening

We will check the temperature of our staff & volunteers. If anyone has a fever, we will ask them to go home. We also ask that you stay home if you answer "yes" to any of the screening questions on the RSVP form.



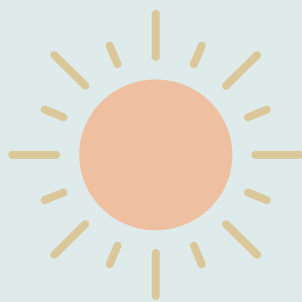
Frequent Cleaning & Sanitizing of the Building

Our worship services are purposefully spaced out throughout the day in order to give time for a full cleaning between services.



Outdoor Services

We will offer outdoor service(s) as often as we are able. You do not have to wear a mask outside, but we do ask you maintain 6ft distance from other households. We will have chairs available, and you are welcome to bring your own.



Capacity Limits

We are open at a limited capacity, so that everyone inside can maintain 6ft of distance from other households. We ask that you RSVP online for the service you plan to attend.



Masks & Music

Current data tells us that singing indoors without a mask greatly increases the risk of COVID-19 spread. We will offer services with and without singing, and we ask that you wear a mask inside the building at all times to help reduce respiratory droplets spreading to other people. We have masks available for those that need one.
